

4. For the following snippets of code, write what would be printed to the terminal. If an error would occur, just write **error**.

(a) `print(7 // 2)`

(b) `print(7 / 2)`

(c) `def spam(eggs):
 return eggs * eggs

ham = spam(spam(2))
print(ham)`

(d) `def spam(eggs):
 return eggs * eggs
ham = spam("Hello")
print(ham)`

(e) `def spam(eggs, ham):
 eggs = ham
 return ham

eggs = 2
ham = "Yumm!"
spam(eggs, ham)
print(eggs)`

(f) `spam = 1

for i in range(5):
 spam = spam / i

print(spam)`
